# Burwood Cricket Club Life Membership Criteria

Life Membership will be offered to those persons who have rendered outstanding and valuable service to Burwood Cricket Club. The award of Life Membership must remain in high regard and a prestigious award which demands long and meritorious service.

Life Membership will be awarded to those that have provided continuous and exceptional membership <u>and</u> service to Burwood Cricket Club, unless exceptional circumstances can be cited. <u>Length of membership alone</u> is not appropriate.

The following categories are the only items of consideration:

- 1. Playing
- 2. Coaching/Managing
- 3. Administration
- 4. General contribution (including social events, recruitment and other categories that the Committee may see as relevant).

Life Membership will be considered for, but not automatically awarded to, people meeting the following criteria in sections below. Nominees must satisfy all items under Section A, at least two under Section B and one under Section C.

#### Section A

- ❖ Financially and/or substantially active member of Burwood Cricket Club for a minimum of 15 years concurrently; and
- ❖ Demonstrated attitude and demeanour that reflects dedication to the values of the club, including the Burwood Cricket Club 6 Non-Negotiables.

#### Section B

- Played a minimum of 150 senior games.
- ❖ Provided valuable leadership to Burwood Cricket Club at any level, including administrative, coaching and/or captaining Burwood Cricket Club teams for a minimum of 5 full seasons.
- ❖ Minimum 10 years in off field specific roles that contribute to the benefit of Burwood Cricket Club.
  - ➤ Roles may include, but not be restricted to service to the Committee, coordinator roles, promotional/marketing activities and other items that the Committee may see as relevant.

### Section C

- \* Representation with distinction at external committees, associations and councils.
- Contributions in lesser administrative and/or coaching roles of significance.
- ❖ Personal contributions of an undeniable and significant benefit to Burwood Cricket Club for a
